Road to Renewal Update

As I'm sure you most of you have heard, a bankruptcy settlement of \$150,000,000 has been reached between the Diocese of Buffalo and the creditors committee representing clergy sexual abuse victims. Parish Families will meet with diocesan officials very soon when each parish will be issued an invoice for their share in the diocesan settlement. The meeting will include parish leaders. Payments are established on a sliding scale based on parish liquid assets. This payment, by each parish, will be a one-lump-sum payment most likely due by mid-summer. More details will follow as I receive them.

I have requested a meeting with the diocese to discuss the further blending of Family 21 and Family 23. Two things that are critical to our moving forward, and that we need to know, are the model of "Family" to be pursued and the leadership structure for the new blended Family. Recall that the Blending of Family 21 and Family 23 involves the additional collaboration between diocesan clergy and the clergy that currently serve the west side parishes of Holy Cross and Our Lady of Hope, the clergy of the Order of Mary Immaculate (OMI) - Fr. Felix Nyambe, OMI, Fr. Stanislaw Zowada, OMI, Fr. Tuan Pham, OMI, and Fr. Lou Loughen, OMI (retired).

Again, details will follow as I receive clarification.

Catholic Relief Services Update:

Ever since she was a young girl, Mariam Fata dreamed of owning her own farm. Her father passed away when she was just six years old and she was taken in by her uncle, a farmer. Many years later, Mariam's dream did come true. She and her husband, a former teacher, bought some land. They worked side by side, planting and harvesting each season. But then tragedy struck a few years ago when an accident left her husband paralyzed. "I had children to care for and was now the only one providing for the family, plus the medical costs," she says. "But I couldn't go to the farm because I had to care for my husband. It had a big impact on our lives." Then, in late 2023, staff from the I Londo I Mai project came to her village. I Londo I Mai, which means "rise up and grow together" in the local language, is funded by USAID. Catholic Relief Services and local partner All for Peace and Dignity manage the project, and provide short-term emergency assistance as well as longer-term development activities.
